## Elective Form Information and How to Access Elective Form Incoming 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Classes

Please follow these instructions very carefully so that we can properly place you.

You will be submitting your elective form online. There will be no pen and paper form. Students who do not fill out an online elective form will be placed into an elective by the Guidance Tech or Counselor. The Google Online Elective Form will open on Monday, 12th at 4:00pm and will close on February 23th at 3:00pm. Once you submit your online form you will not be able to make any changes to the form so choose wisely. If for any reason you need to make a change you will need to see Mrs. Saladow in the Guidance office.. If AVMS offers support classes students will be placed automatically into the class if they meet the criteria. Parents will be notified regarding support classes prior to school starting.

To access your online form simply click <u>7th grade elective form</u> and you should see the appropriate incoming grade level (Incoming 7th Grade). If the link does not work by clicking it, please copy and paste <a href="https://forms.gle/tBrBrLAe6ocigNZ48">https://forms.gle/tBrBrLAe6ocigNZ48</a> to your browser or you can type it in. You MUST use your CUSD assigned Chromebook and your @capostu.org email to access the elective document.

You will select your top 4 choices. Please do not select the same 4 classes. Every attempt will be made to give you your 1st choice, but make sure that you also want to take your 2nd - 4th choice. If you choose to try out for a leadership class (ASB, PAL, Yearbook) you will select Leadership as your choice, and then you must submit a Leadership application where you will select which class you are interested in. ASB, PAL, and Yearbook will all have a common application meaning you only need to fill out one application for these elective choices. The link to the application is 7th/8th Grade Leadership Application. Applications are due no later than February 23rd at 3pm. If the link does not work clicking it please copy and paste <a href="https://forms.gle/vbGJ6efGBNfJiHd2A">https://forms.gle/vbGJ6efGBNfJiHd2A</a>. You MUST use your CUSD assigned Chromebook to access the Leadership Application.

Elective descriptions are available on the AVMS guidance page or you may refer to the presentation. You may only select 2 electives that require an application. Your other elective choice must be one that does not require an application.
