

Elective Information and How to Access Elective Forms and Applications Incoming 8th Grade Classes

Please follow these instructions very carefully so that we can properly place you.

You will be submitting your elective form online. Students who do not fill out an online elective form will be placed into an elective by the Guidance Tech or Counselor. The Google **Online Elective Form will open on February 12th at 4:00pm and will close on February 23th at 3:00pm.** Once you submit your online form you will not be able to make any changes to the form so choose wisely. If for any reason you wish to make a change you will need to see Ms. Parsi in the main office. If AVMS offers support classes students will be placed automatically into the class if they meet the criteria. Parents will be notified regarding support classes prior to school starting.

To access your online form please click [Incoming 8th grade elective form](#) and you should see the appropriate incoming grade level (Incoming 8th Grade) . If you can not access the form by clicking on the link please copy and paste <https://forms.gle/urZqmAQTyKToU6RJ6> into your browser. **You must use your CUSD assigned Chromebook and your @capostu.org email to sign up for classes.**

You will select your top 4 choices. **Please do not select the same 4 classes. Every attempt will be made to give you your 1st choice, but make sure that you also want to take your 2nd - 4th choice.** If you choose to try out for a leadership class (ASB, PAL, Yearbook) you will select Leadership as your choice, and then you must submit a Leadership application where you will select which class you are interested in. ASB, PAL, and Yearbook will all have a common application meaning you only need to fill out one application for these elective choices: **Leadership - [7th/8th Grade Leadership Application](#), Office Aide [Office Aide Application](#), and PE Aide [PE Aide Application](#)** have a separate application. All applications can be found by clicking on the appropriate links above. All applications are due no later than **February 23rd at 3:00pm.** Remember you may only choose two classes with an application and late applications will not be accepted. **You must use your CUSD assigned Chromebook to access and submit your application(s).**
